The Town of Belchertown's Parks and Recreation Department is excited to announce a new project; the creation of Belchertown's first disc golf course, Quabbin Valley Disc Golf (QVDC). The course will be located at the Constantino Field recreation area, behind, and north of the existing soccer field. The land used is owned by the Town of Belchertown, and in cooperation with the Conservation Commission, leverages existing and compliant open space.

Disc golf is one of the fastest growing sports in the country. This is due in large part to the minimal costs associated with playing the sport and developing courses. Disc golf is also a lifetime sport enjoyed by people of all ages and provides a full body form of exercise.

The goal of this project is to add Disc Golf to the expanding list of recreational activities available to both the residents and visitors to Belchertown, alike. In the para-COVID era we find ourselves in, QVDG will also provide a unique opportunity for socially distant outdoor recreation.

To achieve this goal we will design, build, and maintain a 36-hole, competition caliber course that will be highly accessible to everyone and free to play. In addition to the 36 playable holes (18 baskets with 2 unique throwing locations/tee boxes per basket) our course will also offer 3 ADA accessible holes, which can be played independently, at the front of the layout.

We plan to utilize the course for a variety of disc golf related events, such as weekly leagues and tournaments that will attract players to share in the benefits of the natural landscape, and open spaces, of Belchertown.

Sponsorship Regulations

With regards to the programs and properties managed by The Belchertown Parks Recreation Department ("BPRD") the BPRD will not accept sponsorship materials that are disparaging, disrespectful or disreputable to persons, groups, businesses or organizations, including promotions that portray individuals as inferior, evil or contemptible because of their race, color, creed, age, marital status, disability, national origin, ethnic background, religion, sexual orientation, gender, or any other characteristic protected under federal, state or local law.

BPRD will not accept sponsorship materials that are false, misleading, libelous, deceptive or fraudulent.

BPRD shall only accept sponsorships that it deems in its sole discretion that are appropriate to display during activities for children and youth. Consequently, BPRD will not accept sponsorships that advertise products or promote activities that are deemed by BPRD, in its sole discretion, to be harmful, unhealthy, unwholesome or otherwise deleterious to children, including but not limited to the following:

- a. BPRD will not accept sponsorships that relate to an illegal activity or propose a commercial transaction that is prohibited by federal, state or local law, regulation, or ordinance for the localities and partners served by the Department.
- b. BPRD will not accept sponsorships that contain explicit or suggestive sexual material, obscene material, or material harmful to minors
- c. BPRD will not accept sponsorships for X-rated movies, sexually oriented businesses, adult bookstores
- d. BPRD will not accept sponsorships for alcohol or alcohol-related products.
- e. BPRD will not accept sponsorships for marijuana or marijuana-related products.
- f. BPRD will not accept sponsorships for illegal drugs, illegal drug paraphernalia, or legal drugs with sexual connotations.
- g. BPRD will not accept sponsorships for the sale or use of firearms and other weapons.
- h. BPRD will not accept sponsorships that depict violence and will not accept sponsorships that advocate violence of any kind.
- i. BPRD will not accept sponsorships that advocate participation in gangs, cults, or the occult.
- j. BPRD will not accept sponsorships that include language that is obscene or profane.

BPRD will not accept sponsorships for political campaigns, political issues, issue advocacy, public interest, or public service campaigns.

All materials that promote contests or giveaways must comply with all applicable laws and regulations.

BPRD reserves the right to use any sponsorship space for department and other government announcements and information until such space is sold to sponsors.

All sponsorship eligibility decisions determined by the Parks and Recreation Director are final.
